Forest of the City of Norfolk and State of Virginia of the second part, Wreckman; that the said Casling D. Wreckman wrote grounds under the said W<sup>m</sup>. S. Forest, all that certain tract of Land, with all the improvements thereon, and all the ways, rights, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, situated on the Frankfort and Jefferson Road, between Frankfort and Memphis Dep't, in the County of Franklin and State of Virginia, and bounded as following: Beginning at the sign post in the continuation of a line down the South Main road, and running in a straight line northwardly to the Seaboard Railroad Rail Road, thence up said road, southwardly to the line of John B.
