This Deed made this fifteenth day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty seven, between John H. Holmes of the first part, John F. Kindred, Son-in-law of the second part, and the parties herein after named of the other part, Whose rights, as follows; Whereas the said John H. Holmes and his John A. Leach, his wife in the year 1818, purchased of Benjamin B. Kindred & Co. certain tract of Land lying in Northampton County, which said Land was granted and conveyed to the said Leach by Deed of Benjamin & Co. by the said Benjamin B. Kindred and Joseph St. Barthelemy, admission to records in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of said County on the 14th day of November 1818, for which said tract the said Leach & Holmes paid in Cash one thousand dollars each, and the said Leach on the same day executed and recorded a Deed of Trust to secure the payment of the deferred payments of the purchased money, to wit; Twelve hundred dollars, with interest thereon from January 1st 1817, to Joseph H. Barthelemy, the said John F. Kindred, being the Son-in-law of the said Leach, and whereupon the said Holmes was to be equally bound for the payment of one half of the said Twelve hundred dollars, and was to be considered as entitled to one just and equal half of the said tract of Land granted by the said Benjamin B. Kindred and Joseph H. Barthelemy, to be divided by and between the said Holmes and Leach at the will and pleasure of either of them, and whereas the said Land has not been as yet divided and the said Holmes is desirous of securing the payments of certain debts due and owing by him; Now this Deed Witnesseth, that the said John H. Holmes doth hereby grant and convey to the said John F. Kindred, Son-in-law, all of the right, title and interest of the said Holmes in and to the said tract of Land, (the same being one just and equal half of the whole of the said Land) to be divided by the said Son-in-law according to law, to the use and behoof of any party secured and benefited by this Deed, referred to the Deed of Benjamin & Co. from the said Benjamin B. Kindred & Joseph St. Barthelemy being two hundred head, also the following personal property to wit; Four Neahoy grey Sows, two Spring Suck Chairs, two Spring Suck rocking Chairs, two parlor Carpets, two bedstead and furniture, two Wardrobe trunks, parlor Table, two Spring Waggon & harness, one gray Horse, one brown Horse, one brown Colt, with their respective harnesses, and all of the land, garden and peas &c. &c. Now this Deed, to secure the payments of the said debts due by the said Holmes, to wit; one bond to James M. Corbett, for two hundred and eighty seven dollars, one bond to Deacon & Harrison for about three hundred dollars, and a debt for one thousand dollars due by bond to Mrs. Rebecca Thorpe of Bucks County, Pennsylvania - the above amounts being herein stated according to memory - The said Corbett is to be paid in the first place, the said Deacon & Harrison in the second place, and the said Rebecca Thorpe in the third place - Witness the following Signatures and Seals.
