

This Deed made and entered into this 15th day of November 1819, between John M. Gurley of the first part and Thomas Crocker of the second part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars, in hand paid by and before the undersigned and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Crocker, a certain piece or parcel of Land situated in the South Side of Henry River, containing Twenty acres more or less, and bounded by the Land of James Lewis Estate, Susan Lamb and others; It being a part of the Indian Land which was assigned to William Turner and sold by him to James S. French, and the said James S. French sold the said Land to John M. Gurley. I hereby sell and convey unto the said Thomas Crocker all right and title I have unto the above tract of Land, unto him the said Thomas Crocker, his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof, I have affixed my hand and seal the day and date above written.

This Deed made this 15th day of November in the year 1819, between John Williams and Lucy Williams his wife of the first part and James E. Peters of the second part all of the County of Southampton, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ten (\$100.⁰⁰) Dollars, in hand paid by the said James E. Peters, the said John Williams and Lucy his wife do grant bargain and sell to the said James E. Peters, a certain piece or tract of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton, containing (55¹/₂) Fifty five and one half acres, to the said M. Peters or his heirs, and bounded as follows, Beginning at a black gum in the tract of Corners for said Peters and J. S. Camp in said Williams line running about up the branch to a dead pine in said Peters line, thence west up said line to a post Oak a Corner, thence South by a line of Charles Jones to a person named forward of near the road, thence to a short at the road, thence Easterly down the road to a pine at York Road corner, thence to the beginning, and the said John Williams and Lucy his wife do declare and say that they have a full and perfect right to sell and convey the said Land, and do warrant and warrant defend the rights to the said James E. Peters his heirs and assigns against the claims of all persons whatsoever, as witness our hands and seals.
