This Deed made this Sixteenth day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Nine, between John J. Kinard of the first part, and Susan Glover of the second part, Whitefield as follows: Whereas James E. Drake and Richard Drake his wife, late by Deed of Trust recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County of South Carolina, on the 23rd day of May, A.D. 1858, granted and conveyed to the said Kinard as Trustee for certain purposes in the said Deed of Trust, certain tracts of land hereinafter described; and whereas the said Kinard, as Trustee, did make sale of the same according to law, and the terms of the Deed of Trust, and Richard L. Boyant became the purchaser and has fully paid and satisfied the said Kinard for the purchase money which he has distributed to the creditors as directed in the said Deed of Trust; and whereas the said Richard L. Boyant has of you received any and every one of the said tracts of Land to him; and ever done and executed the said Kinard to execute a deed granting the said Land to the said Glover; Now this Deed of Whitefield, that the said John J. Kinard for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, which the said Susan Glover promised and agreed to pay to the said Richard L. Boyant, did grant and convey to the said Susan Glover, all that tract or parcel of Land in the said Deed of Trust mentioned and described as follows; lying in the County of South Carolina, supposed to contain two hundred and fifty acres, more or less, and bounded by the lands of Bennett Barnett, William Drake, Benjamin F. Barnett's heirs and others.
