To the Circuit Court of State of North Carolina,

Whereas, we the undersigned Commissioners, did in a former report on the division of the down of the Widow of Thomas Hadd did fail to define the line as two hundred and down right in the land lying in Southampton County Va. where no other two miles. We then having no directions to employ a Surveyor by said decree, and by the request of the Attorney in said proceeding, we did on the 11th day of October 1868, employ J. C. Mills, a Surveyor of the County of Southampton to Survey the White tract, and it is as follows, to wit, Commencing at a Spruce oak on the Franklin road, running the various courses to a Pine joining Wm. Neely; thence the line running the various courses to the Franklin road, down said road to the said Oak beginning of said Station. Making two hundred and fifty five and a half acres. We then run a dividing line from the said road, commencing at a post near the Church, running to a White Oak, to the line of said Hill and Neely, Making one hundred and twenty four and three fourths acres, in each track. We then set apart the North of the line for the widows five hundred in the land. We then cut off fifty two acres from the other track, which belongs to the Estate of Thomas Hadd, lying on the Franklin road, which we formerly reported, as to the land in State of North Carolina for her down. All of which will be done by the plat herewith annexed. The Surveyor was employed two days in Surveying the land and two chain bearing. All of which we respect-fully submit as a part of our report.
