

The above Survey made Octob^r 15. 1848. by Order and Under the direction of George D. Guy. Treas^r. of the County of Kent and Thomas G. Clements, Commissioners for the dividing and settling the said parties, the tract of Land upon which Barrons Paper and Survey and prospects, containing by actual Survey One hundred and forty Nine acres, two Rods. (249 1/2 A.) divided as follows first by a line beginning at a point on the Franklin road, and running N. 50° E. 84.30 Ch. to a white Oak on Wth side of the road, This line divides the tract into two equal parts, each part containing One hundred and twenty and three fourths acres - The Southern half is divided by a line beginning at the principal dividing line twenty eight chains (4 poles to chain) from the corner point on the Franklin road, and running S 38 1/2° W. to S. Langston's line, cutting off from the Southern half Fifty two acres.
