

This Due Vads This 30th day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and Sixty Nine between William B Rogers President of the Norfolk Bond Company of the first part, and J. W. Urquhart of the other part, witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars and two hundred dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said William B Rogers doth grant unto the said J. W. Urquhart the following property, being the same that was convey'd to the said William B. Rogers, President of the said Norfolk Bond Company by deed of Gilbert Elliott a citizen in Bankruptcy, of the Estate and effects of C. B. Urquhart surviving partner of himself and P. Hennettony deceased late partners, bearing under the firm and style of P. Hennettony & Co., bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1819, of record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton County and in said said described as follows, to wit, "All the right title and interest of the said C. B. Urquhart, in and to what portions of the following described property lying in the County of Southampton Virginia, upon which a lien was placed by the Norfolk Bond Company by virtue of two judgments of the Courts of the Corporation of the City of Norfolk against the said C. B. Urquhart surviving partner and due at the quarterly term 1818, and declared on the judgment docket of the County Court of Southampton County, on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1818, to wit, "Two certain pieces of Land situated in the County of Southampton Virginia on Clarkes Creek, a tributary to the Boykin's River, containing two acres and one half acre, and being the same which was sold and conveyed to Joseph W. Urquhart and wife and C. B. Urquhart and wife by Thomas Ripley and wife, by deed dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May A.D. 1816."
