now owing @ Interest of Sixt Land. This Day Horsford N.Y. the 17th day of
November 1819, Between the said John R. Kirby, of (Trustee) as aforesaid of the one
part, and the said George P. Camp of the other part, W^m. Edwards; That the said John
R. Kirby, as (Trustee) as aforesaid, by and with the Consent and authority of the
said Zachariah E. Holland, (Signed by his Sonning this existing) doth
remise and release unto the said George P. Camp and to his heirs and assigns forever

This Deb of Recd from W.W. Briggs on the 21st day of December 1819, between W.W. Briggs (Commissioneer) appointed by the Govr of the County Court of Southampton County
and to Richard Clements of the first party, Richard Clements of the second party, Horsford N.Y.
as required by the said W.W. Briggs Commissioneer as aforesaid, in pursuance of said
Debt, did acknowledge said Land and Took the same on the 20th day of
January 1820, and at the said S. 2^d year, Richard Clements became the
possessor of the tract of Land known as the homestead lying on the
East side of Pleasant Street, containing by estimation Three hundred
and fifty acres, More or less, for the sum of Eight Hundred and Twenty
five dollars. Now This Deb W^m. Edwards, that the said W.W. Briggs
Commissioneer as aforesaid, for and in Consideration of Eight hundred
and Twenty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Richard Clements
