of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to them paid by the said Martin, the re-
ceipt of which said sum is herby acknowledged, do grant unto Convey to the said
Martin the following tract or parcel of Land, to wit; All that tract or
parcel of Land granted to the said Holland by Deed from Wedge Peper, admitted
to record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton County, in the
Year 1813, which included the Johnson tract and the tract which had been pre-
viously conveyed to the said Peper by Sampson C. Bush. And the said parties of
the first part grant and Convey to the said Martin & partner of the said Con-
veyed to the said John Holland by Deed from the said Dennis Bryant admitted to
record in the above named office, in the 1813, that is to say; All that portion
of the East Branch tract lying North of the branch running through the said
tract East and West w^t yearly 50, and dividing the said tract into two yearly
equal parts, which said branch by Community known as the "Pine Branch";
All the land hereby Conveyed is in the County of Southampton, is supposed to
contain Three hundred acres, more or less, the "Johnson place" lying on the East
Side of the Road leading from the Deep Keys to the Poney Ground, and the said
Land and Bryant's land lying on the West Side of the same road. And the said
