 of Virginia. Witnesseth, that, for and in consideration of the sum of
 four hundred dollars, to them in hand paid and secured to be paid,
 the parties of the first party have given, granted, bargained and sold
 and they have promised, given, granted, bargained and sold unto the party
 of the second party his heirs &c. all their right, title and interest in the
 tract of Land known as "Baptists Ponds", lying and being in the Counties
 of Southampton Virginia and Northampton N. H. Containing two thousand
 and fifty acres, more or less, being the Land conveyed by Deed from
 J. B. Wagnon and E. A. Wagnon his wife, of record in the
 County Clerk's Office, and bounded as follows, beginning at the
 Baptists Bridge in the Mechanics River, thence along the road from
 said Bridge to Baptists Bridge thence by a Branch constituting
 the dividing line between said tract and the Land belonging to
 Henry Handrick Estate, thence along the boundary line between said
 tract and the Land belonging to the Estate of Josiah Wood and of
 Henry Cook, and on the East by the Mechanics, for a Word for
 a better description of which reference is hereby made to Deed
 from J. B. Wagnon and W. J. Phillips to J. B. Cook, of record
 in the County Clerk of Southampton, to have unto the said party his heirs
 interest in said tract of Land - And the said parties of the first
 party covenant to warrant and defend, forever, the premises hereby
 conveyed, against the claims or claims of any and all persons whatsoever.
