Ridley being by me privately examined, separately and apart from her said husband, touching her free consent in the execution of the said List of Commissioners, in her said examination declared that she had executed the same freely, of her own will and accord and without any force, fear or undue influence of her said husband or any other person, and still did voluntarily affix her name -
