This Debt made this 20. day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred
and sixty nine, between William Haines and Narcissa Howell his wife of the County of
Hertford State of North Carolina, and S. W. Bond of the County of Edmund of the said
State of the first party, and Benjamin J. Bryant of the County of Southampton
State of Virginia, of the second party, Witnesseth, as follows: Whereas the said
Haines and wife, did in the year 1861, bargain & sell to William S. Bryant
of the said County of Hertford, State of North Carolina, a certain tract or parcel
of Land lying in the said County of Southampton, and the said William S.
Bryant did fully pay and satisfy the said Haines & wife for the purchase
money for the said tract of Land, but never received a Deed from them
for same, and whereas the said William S. Bryant was in the year 1861
adjudged a Bankrupt, by United States District Court for the District of
North Carolina and the said S. W. Bond was appointed his Appraiser and
proceeded to sell according to law the said tract of Land at auction, on
the day of in the year 1861, and the said Benjamin J. Bryant became
the purchaser for the same of. The receipt of which
said sum paid by the said B. J. Bryant is hereby acknowledged.
Now this Deed Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first party for and
in consideration of the premises do hereby grant and convey to the said Benja-
min J. Bryant, all that tract or parcel of Land above alluded to, which
lies in the said County of Southampton, is supposed to contain one hundred and
two acres, more or less, and is bounded by the lands of James M. Bryant,
Mrs. Wiggins, Amos Copeland and others. And the said William
Haines & wife, and the said S. W. Bond Appraiser as aforesaid, parties of
the first, grant and convey unto said party, title and interest as may
