Potts of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Robert McKendrew Barnes for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty three dollars and twenty five Cents paid by said Edwin R. Potts to Robert S. Barnes, Lucy S. Barnes, Benjamin J. Barnes, W. H. B. Masford and Mary S. Masford, on the 4th day of April 1847, as will appear by their Deed of that date to said Edwin R. Potts for their interest in a certain tract or parcel of land therein described, and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edwin R. Potts, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Robert McKendrew Barnes hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto him the said Edwin R. Potts and his heirs forever all his right title and interest in and to the above described tract or parcel of land, and will by these presents warrant and forever defend the same against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
