Borden and Mary L. Borden his wife of the first party and John H. Borden  
of the second party, Witnesseth, That in Consideration of the sum of Eight hun-  
dred Dollars in hand paid or secured to be paid unto the said James S. Borden  
by the said John H. Borden the said James S. Borden and Mary L. his  
wife doth grant unto the said John H. Borden, all their right title and  
interest in land to a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by adme-  
nition Two hundred and fifty (250) acres, be the same more or  
less, (Grove Gards excepted,) it being the tract formerly held by  
Peter Hark, and known by the name of the lands formerly held  
by Peter Hark, and bounded as following; Beginning at a post  
corner tree in the Seacock road and running W. line of Market street  
to the Barren River Branch, thence up said branch to John H. Borden's  
line, thence along said line to Wm. St. Beal's line to said road and  
down said road to the beginning; the little to said Land was

and date above written.
