Bradshaw and Willig Bradshaw, Justices of the Peace, for the County of Suffolk in the State of Virginia, do certify that Lucy Johnson the wife of Nathan Johnson, whose names are sign'd to the writing annex'd, bearing date December 31<sup>st</sup> 1819, personally appeared before us, in the County aforesaid, and being examined by us, privily and apart from her husband, and hearing the writing aforesaid fully explained to her, the said Lucy Johnson, acknowledged the said writing to be her act, and declared that she had willingly executed the same, and does not wish to retract the same given under her hands this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1819.

This Deed made the 11<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year 1819, between James Briford and Mollie C. Briford his wife, of the two parts, and Matthew Bradshaw of the second part, all of the County of Suffolk and State of Virginia, witness, that in consideration of the sum of Fifty five dollars, the said James Briford, and Mollie C. Briford, his wife, doth grant unto the said Matthew Bradshaw, all their rights title and interest in and to the certain tract or parcels of land containing by estimation fifteen acres, in the said town of Suffolk, it being a portion of land belonging to the said James Briford and Mollie C. Briford his wife.
