Jones of the other part, of the County of Southampton, Westchester, that in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, the said John Burden Hines and Sarah V. his wife doth grant unto the said S. S. Jones all of their right title and interest in & certain tracts or parcels of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation One hundred acres, more or less, bounded as follows, to-wit: North by the Lands of Edward A. White, South and East by the Northward Branch of the Lightwood Swamp, South West by Geo. S. Travis; the said John Burden Hines and Sarah V. his wife do hereby grant, warrant and warrant the title to the said Land in the following Signature and Seal.
