Barkham of the 2nd part, doth certify, that the said John Preble, and John Preble his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty \$30. Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said John and Barkham, do grant, bargain & sell unto the said John & Barkham all of their title, interest and right, to take or dig well in a strip of land in the East Bank of Millway River, two hundred and twenty five (225) feet in length, running back from the River Bank twenty five (25) feet and located as follows, to Commence thirty five (35) feet from a ditch which crosses the County road and empties into the River about 30 or 50 yards to the west of the dwelling house and to extend down the River the said (225) feet as the Bank of the River runs, which is also nearly parallel with the County Road. The plan of which this strip of land is on file, was brought by me at public auction on the 13th day of January 1870, of Joseph J. Barkham, as Trustee, and known as the (John Vaughan tract).
