wife of the first part and Joshua Coby and Schofield G. Barkham of the 2^d part
doth import, that the said John Pringle and E. B. Pringle his wife for and in consideration
of the sum of thirty \$30 Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said Coby and
Barkham, do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Coby & Barkham all of their
title, interest and Right, to take or dig a well in a strip of Land in the
East Bank of Millway River, Two hundred and thirty five (235) feet in
length, running back from the River Bank twenty five (25) feet and
located as follows, the Commencement thirty five (35) feet from a Stake which
crosses the County road and empties into the River about 30 or 50 yards to
the west of the dwelling House and to extend down the River the said (235)
feet as the Bank of the River runs, which is also nearly parallel with the
County Road. The Plan of the same is on file in the Clerk's Office of said County, and
is hereby made a part hereof, and to remain as the same is on file, of
Joseph G. Barkham, as Donor, and to remain as the same is on file, of
the said John Pringle and E. B. Pringle his wife, do hereby warrant
