

This Deed Made this fourth day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty, between Richard L. Bryant of the first part, and John F. Kendrick, (Pursh) of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said R. L. Bryant doth grant and Convey to the said Kendrick, the following property, to wit, all of the real Estate of which the said Bryant is now Seized and possessed, that is to say, the farms on which he now resides being in Southampton County, bounded by the Land of Mrs. Anne Majette, Driscoll J. Majette & others, supposed to contain five hundred acres, more or less; all of the interest of the said Bryant in the tract of Land on which Mrs. George Hill now resides, (two farms of same,) the whole tract supposed to contain Five hundred acres, more or less; all of the interest of said Bryant in the tract of Land which formerly belonged to Miss Lewis E. Bryant, now deceased, and on which she now resides, the whole tract supposed to contain One hundred and twenty seven acres, more or less; also all of the personal and Chattel Estate of every kind now in the possession of or belonging to the said Bryant, to-wit, two or three Cows, five work Cows, about ten Sheep, about thirty Stags, all of the Cows, fatted, Pigs, Poultry, and the Crops or provisions now on hand, all of the farming implements of every description, including two Spring Waggon and one Road Waggon, Carriage, Cook Stoves, plows, one buggy, plow gear, tools &c. also all of his household and kitchen furniture, including Beds, Air Stoves, (stoves) and all fittings, Bureaus, Chairs, Tables, Crockery and glass ware and all other household and kitchen furniture and goods, (also all kind of Tools, Spun accounts or other articles or evidences of indebtedness to the said Bryant now due and owing; also two Collier Fire and running works now on hand; also two Draining Saws and Cedar Works; In Trust, to Secure the payment of a Bond for said Thomas and dollars, of some date with this Deed due to Mrs. S. Pope, and to Secure the said Pope five pounds also left as Surety for the said Bryant in all instances in which he may be bound, and also Secure five pounds all left, being J. Bryant in all instances in which he may be bound as Surety for the said Richard L. Bryant; and also to Secure George H. Sanderson five pounds all left and Thomas as Surety for the said Richard L. Bryant as Administrator of the Estate of Thomas Sanderson deceased. All the above mentioned Surveys and rights to be indivisible and equally and proportionally divided among the following Signatories and Seals
