This Deed made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, One Thousand and Eighty,  
 between R. A. Barrett of the one part, and Calot Everett citizen of (Salem) of the other  
 part, witness; That the said R. A. Barrett does grant with general warranty unto the  
 said Calot Everett, Trustee aforesaid, the following property to wit: One bay horse,  
 1 Mule, 1 head of Cattle, 8 Dogs, one buggy & harness, 3 Carts and harness, and  
 all increase of said stock, and his farming implements, also all crops which the  
 said R. A. Barrett may cultivate and raise during this present year (1870)  
 whether of Corn, ground Peas, Cotton, fodder or other kind,  
 by Trust, to secure the following debts, to wit, To His Majt. att'd.  
 of Alex Britt due - the sum of \$197.44 due by bond dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> of  
 December 1848, and payable two months after date, with interest from date and  
 to which date, and to which Bond Wm St. Daugherty and E. S. Britt and Sec'y;  
 & George Horrocks sum of \$67.00 due by Bond dated 21<sup>st</sup> March  
 1848, payable six months after date, with interest from date and  
 to which C. C. Ferguson and J. P. Tye are Sec'y; To J. P. Tye  
 & other accounts of about \$25.00 now in debt, and to E. B.  
 Tye about \$79.00 due by Bank, with power to said Calot Everett  
 (Trustee) aforesaid to sell said property as the Law authorizes  
 after paying all legal charges, including a Commission of five per  
 cent on such sales, pay the proceeds ratably to said debts -

Witness by a Seal of the Circuit Court of Southampton County, made on the 7<sup>th</sup>  
 day of November 1844, in the cause between plaintiff above named et al. defendant et al.  
 Plaintiff and some others, Sheriff and Committee of His Majt. did recd. and  
 Plaintiff, it was decreed and ordered that John Kilty, (who was theretofore appointed  
 Commissioner for that purpose,) should be in the terms named in said Seal,  
 One Undivided half of a lot of Land at Baypointe, in said County.
