Witnesseth that the said SA Edwards in discharge of the debt and money due to
him by a certain Deed of Bargain and Sale executed by James H. Bell to the said Edwards for
the benefit of James C. Lebed and others, dated April 28th and recorded April
30th 1857, did on the 1st day of April 1870, (having given reasonable notice
to the said Harris,) set up and sell at public auction to the highest bidder, for cash
in hand of Mrs. Edwards' Heir in Personals, a tract of Land (containing
fifty acres, more or less, being a part of the tract of Land purchased by
said James H. Bell of Mrs. Martha Smith, late of New Branchville,
