Edwards as Trustee, certain parcels or tracts of Land situated in the aforesaid County and by authority of which Indt & Sale of said Land was made the 1st day of October the thousand eight hundred and sixty eight (1868.) and Walter B. Holland of the County of Isle of Wight, State of Virginia, having for the sum of One thousand and eighty dollars become the purchaser of the same or parcel of Land situated in the Village of Franklin in which at time of purchase was a warehouse which has since been repaired and converted into a Store house by said Holland, said Store being bounded by the Land of James B. Dickson and others and as situated on the North side of the road or road leading from the said Village of Franklin to Petersburg, and was bought by said Stroft of Richard B. Smith (containing by estimation One fourth of an acre, more or less) and for this Indt Made this the 1st day of July 1870, One thousand eight hundred and seventy, between the aforesaid Luther S.
