This Deed made this 17th day of October in the year 1839, between Shugars Lane
Commissioner appointed by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton
County, rendered at the May Term A.D. 1839, the Sale of which said is made
against Vick, of the first part and Willis Bradshaw of the other part,
Whoseport as follows; Whereas the said Circuit Court did by a
former decree, render in the said said case and direct the sale
at public auction of the said Mill, Mill seat, and such real Estate as
properly belong to the said Vick and part of which said St. Paul
did buy and possess and conveying known as Vick's Mill, and
Whereas at the said sale of the said Mill made by the said Com-
missioner Lane, the said Willis Bradshaw became the purchaser
for the sum of Three hundred and twenty five dollars (\$325.00)
paying a portion of said purchase money in Cash and receiving
the balance for his receipt to wit; Three hundred and twenty five
dollars and twenty five Cents (\$325.75) and whereas the said
Willis Bradshaw has this day fully paid to me the
amount due and owing said Bond, the receipt of which same
is hereby acknowledged; Now this Deed of Conveyance, for
and in Consideration of the premises the said Shugars
Lane as Commissioner aforesaid doth hereby grant and convey
to the said Willis Bradshaw, all the real Estate with
all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging,
improved in which has been property and legally held and
considered as Vick's Mill and Pond, lying in the said
