 doth give and convey unto Henry C. Beale all of her right, title and interest in a
 certain tract of Land lying in the County of Dunkampton Virginia, containing one
 hundred and fifty acres, more or less, the said tract of Land recently purchased
 of Richard L. Beagons and being the Land formerly owned by James Beale and
 the said tract of Land is bounded by the Lands of N. B. Cuthen and
 Bennett Beagons and furthermore the said Susan Glover gives and conveys all of her personal
 and real Estate to the said Beale for and in consideration that the
 said Beale is to take care of (her) Susan Glover, during her natural life,
 taking care of her, means to feed, clothe and furnish, anything necessary
 for her support comfortably under this consideration the said Henry C.
 Beale shall have and hold all the above named property, him and his
 heirs forever, provided he the said Beale employs with the above named
 property, the above named property shall not be taken for any of said
 Beale's indebtedness during said Susan Glover's life time and the above named
 property shall be bound for (her) Susan Glover's support, as witness our
 hands and Seals.
