

Whereas the said Brett having died, the said Richard L. Bryant was by an Order of the said County Court, afterwards appointed Trustee in the place of the said Brett, and whereas the said Hill did make defendant in payment of the debt secured by the said Deed of Trust, and the said Richard L. Bryant after having duly advertised the said tract of Land, sold the same at public auction on the eleventh day of April A.D. 1870, and the said Morris Bernhardt became the purchaser for the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, which said sum he has paid in part, and has secured the payment of the residue; Now This Deed Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the premises the said Richard L. Bryant (Trustee) as aforesaid doth hereby grant and convey to the said Morris Bernhardt with special warranty, all that tract or parcel of Land in the said Deed of Trust mentioned, lying in the said County of Southampton, State of Virginia, is supposed to contain three hundred and four acres, more or less, is bounded by the Land of John Johnson, the heirs of Henry Cook & others and is commonly known as the "Evitts place," together with all the rights and privileges in any manner pertaining to the said tract of Land to him the said Morris Bernhardt and his heirs forever.

This Deed made this eleventh day of April in the year One thousand eight hundred and forty seven, before Bernhardt (Trustee) of the first part and John P. Kindred (Trustee) of the second part, witnesseth, That the said Bernhardt doth grant and convey to the said Kindred the following property to wit, all that tract of Land this day granted and conveyed by Deed of Bargain and Sale from Richard L. Bryant (Trustee) to Deed of trust from Eunett J. Hill recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton County, State of Virginia, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1866, to the said Bernhardt, which said tract of Land is situated in said County, is supposed to contain
