Whitfield, his heirs and assigns forever, all certain tracts or parcels of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing by Estimation two hundred acres, or thereabouts more or less, and bounded by the Lands of Mrs. Linnies Beale, Mrs. John Hall, Miles Woods and others, to have and to hold the above described tracts or parcel of Land and premises West all and Singular to the appointment thereof belonging, as in any writ appointing unto him the said George W. Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of him Geo. W. Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Sarah Ford for her heirs, executors and administrators doth hereby Covenant and agree to and the said George W. Whitfield, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, that she will by these presents warrant and forever defend, all right and titles of the aforesaid tracts or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof, against the claims or demand of and of every other person or persons whatsoever.
