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This Deed made the 19th day of September in the year 1870, between Murdock
 L. Stephenson of the one part and Benjamin Davis of the other, do hereby
 certify the following property to wit, all of the growing crop of wheat,
 corn, clover, all farming implements, all household and kitchen furniture,
 one team, four head of cattle, seven sheep and fourteen head of pigs,
 the said, to secure Levi H. and Richard M. Stephenson for a bond of
 three hundred dollars bearing date in the 19th day of September
 1870. The condition of the above obligation is such that if the said
 Murdock L. Stephenson shall pay the said bond of three hundred
 dollars to the said Levi H. and Richard M. Stephenson, then
 this Deed to be null and void, if not, the said Benjamin
 Davis proceed to sell before such terms as the parties shall agree
 upon, after giving due notice, all the property herein before
 mentioned and with the amount realized from such sale,
 pay off said bond, and should there be more than enough
 for such purpose, then the remainder to be paid to the
 said Levi H. and Richard M. Stephenson, of said Murdock L. Stephenson.
