This Deed made the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year 1870, between Mardon  
 L. Stephen of the one part and Benjamin Brister of the other, Whitefield,  
 that the said Mardon L. Stephen doth grant unto the said Benjamin  
 Brister the following property to wit: all of the growing crop of wheat,  
 corn, oats, all farming implements, all household and kitchen furniture  
 two horses, four head of cattle, seven sheep and seventeen hens to buy  
 in trust, to Leon W. and Richard M. Stephen for a sum of  
 Thru Hundred dollars bearing date in the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September  
 1870. The consideration of the above obligation is such sum of the sum  
 of Mardon L. Stephen shall pay the said sum of Thru hundred  
 dollars, to the said Leon W. and Richard M. Stephen, the  
 said Deed to be good and valid, if not, the said Benjamin  
 Brister may proceed to sue upon such terms as the parties shall agree  
 upon, after giving due notice, all the property hereinbefore  
 mentioned and with the amount realized from such sale,  
 pay off said sum, and should there be more than enough  
 for such purpose, then the remainder to be paid to  
 the wife to the other creditor of said Mardon L. Stephen
