One bond for two hundred & fifty dollars, due January the first A.D.
1871, one other bond for four hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty
two cents, due January 1st 1872, One other bond for the like amount
of \$413.32 (due January 1st A.D. 1873 and two other bonds
for the like amount of \$413.32 each,) due January 1st A.D.
1874, all bearing date of even date with the said Deeds, and bearing
