Elsie Lewis wife of the second party, certain tract of land known as "The Farmer's Pasture"  
containing forty acres bounded and described as follows: being west of her house and bounded  
by the Land of George Gardner, of Colchester Reservoir, Mr. John Edwards and others  
and bounded on the south and east by the boundary of the said tract of land by the Plaintiff Robert
