

This Deed made the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May in the year 1870, between William Hodgeforth and Nancy Hodgeforth his wife of the one part and Elizabeth Burfitt of the second parts all of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia, Wm. Hodgeforth being an inhabitant of the town of Gloucester, Va., the late William Hodgeforth and Nancy Hodgeforth his wife, both granted unto the late Elizabeth Burfitt all their right, title and interest, etc. out to her certain tract or parcels of land belonging by estimation 128 acres acre, in the same County of Gloucester (it being the tract of Land formerly belonging to James Clayton,) and is bounded by the lands of Edward Burfitt, and the East, and south by David Hill property, and by James Burfitt, South by late William Hodgeforth Hodgeforth the following boundaries and corners,
