Know all men by these presents, that on the 1st day of November A.D. 1870, between
 me, William S. Barbam of the City of Gloucester Hills, State of Virginia, of the County of
 & S. West, Suffolks, Virginias, of the one part and C. F. Harris, Clerk of the said
 same, the other, witnesseth that whereas on the 1st day of November 1870, the said Clerk
 1870, W. Barbam by his said Clerk, and the said William S. Torre, did take certain
 tract of Land with the improvements thereon and all the trees, rights, franchises
 and appurtenances thereof situated in the Township of Gloucester, County, Virginia,
 bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the highest point of the continuation of
 a line now the South Ferry road and running in a straight line Northwardly
 to the Seaboard of Gloucester Point Road, thence of the said road Eastwardly
 by the line of School St. Langley, thence along said line down the
 Cutwater Branch to the Cedar Swamp, thence down and through the center
 of said swamp to the body of water now called Lake Tuckahoe,
 thence along the said road to the place of beginning, and by a straight
 continuing line Southwest and forty acres, more or less, being the land
 tract of land conveyed to said Barbam by Stephen S. Barbam his wife
 in said to secure the payment of a sum for the sum of Three Thousand
 and Five hundred dollars, received by the said Barbam to the said
 Barbam payable twelve months after date, with interest from date
 date, allowing him three days after date, and enclosed the said Barbam
 for part off and discharge the Clerk to the said Barbam, which the
 said Barbam doth acknowledge. Therefore in consideration of the premises
 and with the consent and approbation of the said Barbam signified
 by his signing this present the said W. S. Torre doth release and
 convey to the said C. F. Harris the above described tract
 of land and premises with all the appurtenances thereon
 belonging, and the said W. S. Torre, conveys the same unto the said
 Barbam that he will warrant Stephen H. Torre, his property, above mentioned
 with the following signatures and initials.
