Wrote the 30th day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven Davis Vick Receiver of the one part and Sampson Johnson Son-in-law of the other part, witnesses that the said Davis Vick did give unto the said Sampson Johnson, Son-in-law, the following property, to wit: the whole of my tract of land on which I was under lease in the County of Northampton unto State of Virginia, containing One hundred and eighty eight acres, 2400 or less, bounded by the South of Thomas Birtley and others, the same to be shown the property of the following debt due to Robert L. Brown one hundred and thirty two dollars and ten cents, bearing said debt with its long date, also the following debt due to S. S.
