In pursuance of a Ind. of Court, duly presented to me as Clerk by William Steele and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County and State of Virginia on the 28th day of February in the year 1870, to George Andrew Smith Henry Woodland and James of Jones of Kings & St. George, J. S. Henry H. C. Bailey (Sons), after advertising the same, did on the 12th day of December 1870, the Lords in the Court of Family Affairs, Masters and James of Jones and Robert M. Stiles, Lessees the purchasers for the same of Five Hundred and two dollars and 85^{cts} Cents, of which amount James of Jones paid one hundred and fifty two dollars, and Robert M. Stiles paid the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars and 85^{cts} Cents, and J. S. Henry H. C. Bailey, as Lessee, aforesaid, did grant unto the above named parties James of Jones of Robert M. Stiles, purchasers aforesaid, all my right title and interest in the tract or parcels of Lands aforesaid, lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing by estimation Two hundred and eleven acres, more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit: E. by the Land of John J.
