 I. Story, lately deceased of Laramie, Wyoming and his wife, Containing many
 years past, never up the boundaries of which was appear to examining him
 Date Story, according to have for the cause bearing date as the 1st day of
 January 1871. In Story, to have the property of a certain debt due to
 Laramie Daughter, for the sum of Two Thousand Dollars by her signed
 the said William D. Story, as bearing interest from the 1st day of January
 1871. And if it should become necessary to have the said debt in payment of
