

Whereas John A. Kelly, as assignee in Bankruptcy of John B. Graham, did at the 15th day of January 1871, bring into Court the said John B. Graham and Joseph F. Campbell a last of said in Bankruptcy Court Virginia, containing four hundred and twenty three acres, more or less, and appearing by the said John B. Graham and Joseph F. Campbell, and also by the said John A. Kelly, to the same parties as above in said and franchises and ten Land in the South end of said same, and whereas by said same and of said same retained in said property to secure the payment of three hundred dollars, part of the purchase money of said property, and which has since been paid to the said Thomas, under the 21st day of December 1870, between the said John A. The Indenture made the 12th day of January 1871, between J. B. Graham of the first part and J. A. Kelly of the second part, whereby the said J. A. Kelly by a deed of said day made and recorded, dated on the 11th day of February 1869, did grant and convey to the said J. B. Graham (Vendor) a tract of lands situated in Southampton County containing about two acres and bounded by the Land of R. C. Walker, Anthony Weaver, William Brown and the said Graham, whereas interest in said same was and in the real estate and in the possession of his estate Elizabeth Thomas and whereas under the said Thomas possessed in the lands of Chapel, Church and all the land the said Thomas and Joseph, consisting of two acres, four rods of Cedar, hogs, household and kitchen furniture, farming utensils, riding vehicles and the crop the very so grown in the same, on which the said Thomas resides, the same to secure the payment of a debt due to the said Thomas by said J. B. Graham, and the said John B. Graham, on the 1st day of 1871, and the said two hundred and fifty dollars, and whereas the said Thomas may so have the estate of John B. Graham by the said Thomas, and whereas the said Thomas have been paid, and the proceeds for which said debt was recorded
