 H. Lawrence, with child H. his wife, in Consideration of the sum of One
 Hundred Dollars, have granted, conveyed and sold, and do hereby grant,
 bargain and sell, unto the said James Langford, a certain piece or
 parcel of Land containing by estimation about twenty two and a half
 and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a Maple or Hardwood
 corner line on the side of a road or the side of a hill, of
 William Hooper fifty feet from said road bearing up to another
 side, thence to a Spruce thence to a Spruce thence to a black gum,
 thence to a black gum, thence keeping the said distance of
 the River to a small Spruce; thence along a line of marked
 trees to a oak oak tree the said Oak tree; thence along a
