convey and sell, make over, transfer, and convey to the said Abraham Jones and
Eliza Jones of the second parts, all the right, title and interest which the said
said Abraham Jones of the first part, doth or will by grant, devise or otherwise
have in his late Wife's Eliza Jones son in a certain tract of Land, yet undivided
in kind, of which the said Eliza Jones has, had, signs and property, consisting
of certain land bounded on Long Lane at Half way, including the several
