 Head of the said Mr. McAndrews Estate, who granted unto the Bank of W. H. Briggs  
 aforesaid Debtor, with general warranty, his premises, property, & wife,  
 all situated & lying in the tract of Land formerly belonging to my Husband  
 as lying in the County of Schenectady, adjoining the Banks of Blue R. Horne,  
 Fox River, C.R. Bayley and others, together with the sum of One Thousand  
 & my Daughter Anna Horne, Estate, containing Two Hundred acres, (200)
