This Deed made the 17th day of August 1871, between John E. Griffel, the grantor
 of the first part and Charles E. Long, the grantee of the second part, witness, that
 in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and forty Dollars to the said John E.
 Griffel in hand paid to the said Charles E. Long at and before the delivery of these
 presents and the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Charles E.
 Griffel doth grant unto the said Charles E. Long a certain tract of land lying
 in Southampton County containing one hundred and forty one acres, more or less,
 and bounded by the said tract of land of John E. Griffel, and the said
 tract of land of James H. Gammill, E. Griffel, formerly of James Griffel, all the said
 premises to Griffel according the title to the said tract of land as the said
 Charles E. Long acquired the same or derived of all or any other person or
 persons of whom? In witness whereof the said Deponent E. Griffel has hereunto
 set his hand and seal the day and year above written

This Deed of Deed made the 17th day of August 1871, between John E. Griffel, the grantor
 of the first part and Benjamin E. Applegate, the grantee of the second
 part, witness, that the said John E. Griffel, in consideration of the sum of
 two dollars to him now paid, doth give, grant, Bargain and sell unto the
 said Benjamin E. Applegate, all his growing Crop of Corn, Cotton, Corn
 fields, grass and ground, &c., & also all the produce growing from said
 occupying his land for the year 1871, and paid to him as rent, advances, to
 taxes & debt, amounting to One Thousand dollars and due to him at
 Applegate, Benjamin E. Applegate, and Charles E. Griffel, the amount
 of which can be easily ascertained by reference to a list furnished
 in the court house of Southampton County Applegate and others.
