

The Survey Decree by the said Court of Dms, was in a Credit of twelve hundred, and returning the said Decree became the purchase of the said Court of Dms for the sum of the Hundred Dollars, And they said decreed, that the said Geo. J. Randall, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars, paid to him by the said Decree, the receipt of which said sum is being acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey, with said John Rockwell, and that said as parcel of land in the said Court of Dms mentioned, containing the bounded and being five acres, more or less, and bounded by the lands of George H. Tisdale, Margaret C. Tisdale and others, all being the same as appears the said Rockwell's own records. And the said Geo. J. Randall, grants and conveys, with such rights, title and interest, in the said parcel of Land hereby granted, as may be seen in him in said Decree.

Holt and Ross Holt of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of the first part, and James Dyer, Jr. of the aforesaid County and State of the second part, Witnessed, that the said Elizabeth J. Holt and Ross Holt for and in consideration of the sum of two dollars, being in hand paid by the said James Dyer, Jr., the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, convey and confirm, unto the said James Dyer, Jr. his heirs, administrators and assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece of Land, situate in the County of Southampton, bounded in the East by the Lands of the said James Dyer, Jr. and on West by Smith's Ferry Road, containing one acre, more or less, that part of the said Land, being one of the Lands of Elizabeth J. Holt and Ross Holt lying East of the road running from the Church to the Southern Parkers, together with all in appurtenances thereto, both in interest, of the said Elizabeth J. Holt and Ross Holt, to the said James Dyer, Jr. and his heirs forever.
