and of the State of Virginia, residents, both whereof by \square done, in the City of
Doovi, in the County of Southampton, having this, the said Convention
assembled, amongst other things, after the premises of the date of 1868,
against W. H. Bishop, by the said Bishop, to cause to him the said
Bishop, a Deed with Deed of warranty for the tract of land for which
said land was seized, and affirms the said W. H. S. Bishop, has fully
paid in satisfied hands him \$7000 - Now therefore, the said undersigned
doth the said W. H. St. John, Southampton, as aforesaid, for and in consideration
of the premises, and in the further sum of one dollar, without
fees to him, doth grant and convey unto the said W. H. S. Bishop, with
special warranty that tract of land known as "The Land," to
said W. H. St. John, his heirs and assigns, with all rights, title and
privileges the day and year above written.
