Margaret E. his wife, doth grant unto the said Robert M. Tolson, all that tract of  
Land known as the "Howard's Land," and bounded by the lines of J. W. Lawrence,  
Henry Beatty and others, and as is shew'd by Surveyor Surveyor, Calverley  
etc., now or before, and the said parties of the first part do generally  
the property hereby conveyed through the following description etc. etc.

by us jointly and apart from her husband, doth declare the writing aforesaid  
fully explained to her, the said Margaret St. Lawrence acknowledged  
the said writing to be her act, and declare she had willingly executed  
the same, and doth intend to release to John Tolson and family the 27<sup>th</sup>  
day of May 1841.

said R. D. Price with general agreement the following property to wit, all of their Stock of  
Hogs and their future increase, all of their Cattle and future increase, the property real,  
Catt and cattle, forming supplements to every kind, worth £1000 of Guinea or £500, about  
1500 lbs. of bacon fat, and all household and kitchen furniture, for future requirements, at  
10/- per bushel and Scots this day and doth above mentioned,
