Witnesses, by & power of the County Court of Huntington County made us day
of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty three, at & before
the Court of the County Court of Huntington County, in the County of Huntington,
Indiana, Present David Lanning and Stephen J. Scott, Notary Public, of said
County, & we do hereby certify that the foregoing instrument was executed
and signed by us before us on the 1st day of October, A.D. 1843, in the presence of the
witnesses named in the power, and that the signatures of the parties thereto
are genuine and that the instrument contains no forged or altered writing.
In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands, this 1st day of October,
A.D. 1843, before the County Court of Huntington County, being County Court, shall be written in
writing, the real estate agreed upon in the following power to purchase, by
Roswell S. Myrick, in the sum of \$1000 - that is to say, I, Roswell S. Myrick,
in the City of Cincinnati, Ohio, bounded and tightly close along, and in top
and bounds as follows, by the Lands of John H. Hunt, who gave said property
to Roswell S. Myrick and Anna Bogard, and to the purchased money to be paid him
as aforesaid price on or before the 1st day of May, 1843, the same, by C. further bound
by the back hand made as the day of May, 1843, in said Court, it is my mind
to obtain that the back back back power and agreement as aforesaid, Made to the said
said Roswell S. Myrick & his wife Sparrow Myrick, in the name from me
the true intent agreeable - This Deed, therefore, Made this 1st day of May
one thousand eight hundred and forty three, this between us both, for the sum
