Hoddy of Durham, which is the County of Wakefield in the State of Virginia, my true & lawful attorney to do all in my name, place and place of residence, (Confederate or as long and as
possible) to do and to execute and to pass through to the person or persons to whom he may be sent paper documents or other acts of business called and given him
to Edward E. Hoddy in my name, as far as may be granted to my said attorney, for such
as authority to do and perform and to sign and seal as being sufficient authority
so reserving to him to do and to pass through to all acts & purposes as I might or
cause to be personally present, and fully furnish his substitute, thereby
ratifying & confirming all that may have been done or his substitute done
thereby, so far as to be done by him herself,
and thereby I have executed let my said to her the 2^d day of
October in the year 1872.
