Kelly Commissioners for the purpose that the said Edward Kelly who was by said Deed appointed a Commissioner for the purpose that he sell to the said James W. Davis the sum of one mill and one tenth of a mill or twenty mills and whereof the said Edward Kelly as Commissioner aforesaid in pursuance of said Deed proceeded to advertise the said one mill and one tenth of a mill or twenty mills at the public auction on the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1872, sold the said sum one mill and one tenth of a mill or twenty mills to the plaintiff, where the said sum was paid and by Colman C.
