and Consideration of the sum of One Thousand & Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800) who said Mary Ann H. Cane does
grant, with general warranty, unto the said Brooks H. Cane and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following
real estate, to wit: A lot or parcel of land, in the village of Brookville in the same County, which was formerly
