of his debts paid in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. The said party of the first part
doth grant, bargain & sell not by these presents to him or his assigns, his wife & wife unto the said party of
the second part with good warranty all his right title and interest in and unto a certain tract of land
lying in the County of Southampton containing by ultimate and hundred and sixty five acres more
or less and bounded on the North by the River of Shuey Run on the East by the Land of G. G.
Markman in the South by the Land of John Cott and on the West by S. B. Pease to have and
to hold the same forever. Doth trust to receive the full and complete payment of the sum of one thousand
and seventy dollars and sixty cents with interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent, payable to John Cott
on or before the 1st day of January 1876. As witness to the truth aforesaid. And the said
party of the first part, Consents with the said party of the second part that should be the said
party of the first part make default and fail to pay the amount of said tract with interest thereon, on or
before the 1st day of January 1876 the said party of the second part shall have reasonable value there
of unpaid and sell by public auction the property herein contained and the same to his further account to
