Chapman and his wife and agents present the following recite, to wit, at their home in a house upon County Road No. 10, containing five hundred and fifty four acres more or less, and bounded by the Lands of Reuben Williams, Harvey Stephen, John Cott, the late George R. Riddings and others, formerly belonging to the late Joseph Butler, which said lands the said Robert S. Butler retained title to as of the time of his decease and by provision of the will being to the said John Butler wife, J. L. Holland and wife the S. J. Edwards wife of the said John D. Chapman on the 2d day of December 1873, duly recorded in Washington County, Virginia together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging to the same. And the said Robert S. Butler conveys that he has the right to convey the said land to the said John D. Chapman, that the said John D. Chapman has good and sufficient title to the said land, that he has power of sale to convey the same and that his wife consent such further conveyance of the said land as might be required.
