

This deed made this the sixth (6th) day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred twenty three between Allen Bramble grantor of the one part and H. R. Griffiths chosen at trustee (both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia) witnesseth that the said Allen Bramble doth grant with general warranty unto the said H. R. Griffiths trustee of said the following real property to wit: a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of R. J. H. Nalley, Sr. as by Order made by the Land of James Broadshaw decess. and containing by estimation one hundred fifty seven acres or less, it being the tract or parcel of land known as the "Potomac Southampton tract" and bought by the said Allen Bramble from Alexander Sandford & Maribel A. his wife of the State of North Carolina & by date dated 6th December 1872 conveyed by said Sandford & his said Maribel Bramble, said land being conveyed by said Allen Bramble unto said H. R. Griffiths in trust to secure the following debt to wit: one note made by said Allen Bramble and dated the 1st day of January 1876, and payable to H. W. Griffith & Sonners R. Deason under the firm & style of H. W. Griffith & Co. said note being due December 20th 1878. Witness the following signatures and seals.

Gay of all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, and Nelson Council of the County & State of said of the second part. Witnesseth that the said David C. Vaughan wife and Sarah J. Gay of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of five thousand two hundred eighty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Nelson Council of the second part to the said David C. Vaughan wife & Sarah J. Gay of the first part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Nelson Council Vaughan wife and Sarah J. Gay have conveyed sold and confirmed, and by the these presents doth convey and confirm unto the said Nelson Council his heirs and assigns forever all of their right title and interest in and to and certain part of a parcel of land, being one being situated in the County of Southampton State of Virginia, and in the Village of Brookline, on the North side the R. R. R. R. Road commencing at the east corner of the tract formerly owned by R. J. Edwards thence along the said Edwards line 210 feet to first corner thence along the line of said Edwards to the edge road that formerly ran from Brookline Depot to R. R. water Spring 222 1/2 feet thence down the edge by line of old road to the Main road line 207 feet thence along the said road line 158 feet to the first station, to have and to hold the aforesaid lot a parcel of land and aforesaid tract with all the appurtenances thereto, belonging or in any way appertaining thereto unto the aforesaid Nelson Council his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only
